#### THE SHOW ...



IPA\*, puppet show is a comedy for all ages inspired by the traditional glove puppet shows that have been performed since antiquity in streets, squares and parks of European towns and cities.

Although traditional in its form and dramatic structure, it is contemporary in its dynamic and rhythmic execution as well as the modern day characters that appear. The show captivates the audience with an energetic manipulation rarely seen, a succession of situations, confrontations and gags that refer us to the classic and universal themes of good and bad, love, fight against abuse, friendship... all eagerly braced by spectators of all ages, who participate in the action and influence in the rhythm of the show.

Age: Recommended for family audiences with children from 3 to 12 years old.

Duration: 45 minutes

Synopsis: PIPA does not want a quiet and peaceful life, he wants to play, to have fun, to fall in love, to live life ... But he will find a world full of surprising characters: Mister Tofol and his selfie stick, Nina and her ice cream, the Banker and his machine, and even with a very hungry crocodile and its bubbles. It is a crazy, often surreal and tender comedy for puppets.

\*"Pipa" means sunflower seed in Spanish. The hero of our show owes its name to the famous piece of Ai Wei Wei "Sunflower Seeds" (exhibited in the Tate Modern, 2010). A work composed of 100 million handmade porcelain sunflower seeds; where each sunflower seed represents the individual and its freedom, and the whole set of seeds represent the people, capable of transforming things.





#### NESTOR NAVARRO - LA PUNTUAL

a Puntual was founded in 2005 as the only theatre for puppets, marionettes and shadow-puppets for family audiences in Barcelona. The director of the company is Eugenio Navarro, puppeteer since 1976 and a founding member of the historic company "La Fanfarra" with Toni Rumbau and Mariona Masgrau. "La Fanfarra" had many international successes in the 80's and 90's. After the dissolution of the company, Eugenio created his own repertoire of shows, opened La Puntual Puppet Theatre and is considered one of the puppet masters of Catalonia today. Eugenio Navarro was President of UNIMA-Spain between 1985-1989, and has been director of several national and international festivals.


éstor Navarro Salvany (Barcelona, 1982) was born and grew up among artists, puppets, stages and van tours. After a long stay in Mexico, where he participates in the theatre company of the University of Monterrey, he realizes that the stages where he played as a child call him again. Once back in Barcelona he collaborates in

the opening of La Puntual in 2005 and works at the box office. It was in 2008 that he initiated his puppetry career as a shadow performer, giving voice and movement to Malic, the hero of the stories performed by La Fanfarra.

He goes professional in 2013 with his first show, "To Babel on a scooter", produced with the collaboration of Barcelona City Council. Followed by "The Shadow of Pinocchio", premiered at the GREC Festival of Barcelona, and toured around all Spain in 2015. Finally, in 2016 he premiered "PIPA PUPPET SHOW", an up to date recovery of the traditional Catalan glove puppets.

Eugenio and Néstor Navarro are the resident company of La Puntual, but also participate in local, national and international festivals. Every year, La Puntual hosts the "Winter Puppet Festival".

La Puntual attracts international companies of renowned prestige, as well as companies from the rest of Spain. In addition, it gives and organizes courses specialized in the art of puppets, shadows and marionettes.

Minimum performing space of  $3m \times 3m \times 3m$ . The show is suitable for indoors and outdoors performances. Outdoors protected from the wind.


One 220v. plug.

Sound equipment suitable for space.

Set up: 1.30 hours.

Strike: 1 hour.


